

SPECIAL EDUCATION MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will permit the intermediate school district to continue to levy the maximum mills for special education previously approved by the electors. The revenue raised by the proposed millage will be levied and collected by the intermediate school district and will be used to fund special education services to students with disabilities who attend local schools.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of .2273mill (\$0.2273 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation), on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Eastern Upper Peninsula Intermediate School District, Michigan, to provide funds for the education of students with a disability, be renewed for a period of 4 years, 2015 through 2018, inclusive; the estimate of the revenue the intermediate school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2015 is approximately \$510,500 from local property taxes authorized herein (this is a renewal of millage which will expire with the 2014 tax levy)?
