

**CHIPPEWA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
RESOLUTION
APPORTIONMENT OF 2014 MILLAGES**

At a meeting of the **CHIPPEWA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS** held on OCTOBER 13, 2014,

WHEREAS, the County Board has reviewed all of the millages requested by the various taxing entities operating within the County, and has considered the allocated and extra voted millages to which the each entity is entitled, and determined that the levy of the millage rates listed on the 2014 MILLAGE REPORT presented to the Board by the Equalization Director and made a part of the minutes, will be necessary for the sound management and operation of the taxing jurisdictions, and

WHEREAS, the County Equalization Director has informed the County Board that pursuant to MCL 211.34D, each requested millage on said report has been reduced, if necessary, in compliance with section 31 of article 9 of the state constitution of 1963, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. THE 2014 MILLAGE REPORT BE APPROVED AS PRESENTED
2. THE CLERK AND EQUALIZATION DIRECTOR ARE HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO COMPLETE AND FILE ANY REPORT REQUIRED BY THE STATE OF MICHIGAN, RELATIVE TO THE MILLAGES AUTHORIZED BY THIS BOARD, INCLUDING THE 2014 APPORTIONMENT REPORT.
3. THE MILLAGES SO APPROVED SHALL BE SPREAD AGAINST THE APPROPRIATE TAXABLE VALUES IN THE VARIOUS TAXING UNITS WITHIN THE COUNTY TO PRODUCE THE 2014 TAX ROLLS AND THOSE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SPREADING AND COLLECTING THOSE TAXES SHALL BE CHARGED WITH THE PROCESSING AND COLLECTING OF THOSE TAXES ACCORDING TO STATUTE.

*****NOTE: CHIPPEWA COUNTY HAS APPROXIMATELY 50,000 ACRES WHICH ARE SUBJECT TO THE COMMERCIAL FOREST ACT WHICH IS SUBJECT TO A SPECIFIC TAX RATE OF \$1.25 PER ACRE.

THE COUNTY ALLOCATED AND STATE EDUCATION MILLAGES ARE LEVIED IN JULY. NOTE: LEVY FOR DETOUR VILLAGE OPERATING PURPOSES WAS 9.0837 MILLS IN JULY 2010, JULY 2011, JULY 2012, JULY 2013, JULY 2014

FOR THOSE PROPERTIES CLASSIFIED INDUSTRIAL PERSONAL PROPERTY, OR QUALIFIED FOR 100% EXEMPTION FROM SCHOOL OPERATING MILLAGE, DEDUCT FULL AMOUNT OF SCHOOL OPERATING MILLAGE FROM TOTAL ANNUAL TAX RATE.

FOR THOSE PROPERTIES QUALIFIED FOR LESS THAN 100% EXEMPTION FROM SCHOOL OPERATING MILLAGE, DEDUCT EXEMPTION PERCENTAGE OF SCHOOL OPERATING MILLAGE FROM TOTAL ANNUAL TAX RATE.

FOR THOSE PROPERTIES CLASSIFIED COMMERCIAL PERSONAL PROPERTY, DEDUCT 12 MILLS FROM SCHOOL OPERATING MILLAGE FROM TOTAL ANNUAL MILLAGE LEVY.

BRIMLEY SCHOOLS PASSED A 1.5 SINKING FUND MILLAGE IN 2012. THAT MILLAGE IS INCLUDED IN DEBT COLUMN ABOVE.

SUPERIOR DISTRICT LIBRARY DOES NOT LEVY MILLAGE IN DETOUR, TAHQUAMENON, and WHITEFISH SCHOOL DISTRICTS

***REGARDING CITY OF SAULT STE MARIE ONLY: CITY MILLAGES, COUNTY ALLOCATED, STATE ED MILLAGES, HALF OF SCHOOL OPERATING and SCHOOL DEBT MILLAGE IS LEVIED IN SUMMER.

****THE CITY OF SAULT STE MARIE HAS THREE TAX INCREMENT FINANCING AUTHORITIES (TIFA) WITH A TOTAL CAPTURED VALUE OF \$22,530,108. AND SENIOR CITIZEN PILT VALUE OF \$405,500 WHICH IS EXEMPT THE CITY ALSO HAS AN IFT DISTRICT VALUED AT \$1,249,100 TAXED AT LESS THAN FULL RATES.
